Hahn personal best 13 K's, 5-1 on season

Cory Hahn overcame a tough start to get the win, after giving up 7 runs in the first 2 innings. Hahn finished the game with 13 strike-outs, and improved to 5-1 on the season. Hahn leads the team in wins and innings pitched. It looked like a miserable day in the making, as the 1st Charlotte batter hit the 1st pitch of the day for a home run. Hahn went on to give up 6 more runs in the next 2 innings, but then staged one of the most impressive comebacks ever witnessed in Turchin Stadium. Over the next 6 innings, he allowed only 1 earned run, and struck out 9 Charlotte batters.

For the offense, Miami transfers Greg Dini and Matt Barket drove in 7 of the Wave's 13 runs, and scored 5 of the Wave's 13 runs. Tommy Manzella finished his hot week (.600) going 3-4 with 2 runs, and a rbi. Other multiple hit batters included Nathan Southard (2-3, 3 walks), Joe Holland (2-6), and Wes Swackhammer (3-5).

The Green Wave extended their win streak to 6, and their 5th straight in C-USA.

Freshman Daniel Latham picked up his 1st collegiate win, as he pitches 4.2 scoreless innings in relief of started J.R. Crowel. Latham allowed only 4 hits, and struck out 3, shutting down the potent 49er offense.

On the offensive side, Matt Barket drove in 3 runs, and the combination of Barket, Dini and Manzella scored 5 of the Wave's 9 runs. The most important run of the night came from Greg Dini. With the game all tied up in the bottom of the 7th, Dini lead off the inning with a home run. The Wave went on to score 3 more runs, increasing their lead to 4. That was more than enough for Daniel Latham, as the Wave won their 4th straight C-USA game, and their 5th straight overall.
